Requirements for M365 CoPilot (early information)

Here is a detailed story about what we can expect from M365 CoPilot. At a high level it looks like the AI functionality will be an add-on to E3 and E5 licenses. It also looks like there will be requirements relating to Information Governance in addition to a Microsoft Loop account. Microsoft has a lot of hoops to get through before it can be released including making sure they are not breaking European Data Boundary rules.
